IN pursuance of Air Force Regulation 439, I Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby declare the area described in the schedule hereto to be a bombing range for the purpose of the said regulation on the first, second and third days of December, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.

Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine and in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign.



All that area of land in the parishes of Evans and Esk, County of Richmond, in the State of New South Wales, and all that area of the sea being part of the South Pacific Ocean, which together are bounded by the circumference of a circle of 6,000 feet radius, the centre of which circle is at a point distant 8,600 feet on a magnetic bearing of 143 degrees 10 minutes from the North Eastern Corner of Water Reserve 1977 notified 14th July, 1866, in the said parish of Feb.
