NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PROPOSE CUSTOMS TARIFF ALTERATION NOTICE No. 2 (1971)

IN pursuance of section 273EA, of the Customs Act 1901–1971, I, DONALD LESLIE CHIPP, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that it is intended, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this Notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament a Customs Tariff alteration in accordance with the particulars specified in the Schedule to this Notice and operating on and from the eighteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-one.

THE SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS OF PART II. OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE CUSTOMS TARIFF 1966-1971

- 1. Omit note 5 to Chapter 15, insert the following notes:-
 - "5. Where a mixture of oils containing castor oil falls within sub-item 15.07.1, the mixture shall, for the purposes of that sub-item, be deemed to consist wholly of—
 - (a) if there is a greater quantity, by weight, of castor oil than the other oil or oils taken together—castor oil;
 - (b) in any other case—the other oil or the oil in the mixture (other than castor oil) of which there is the greatest quantity, by weight, and if there are two or more oils present in equal quantities and any one of those oils is present in quantity greater than any other oil (other than castor oil)—such one of those oils present in equal quantities as the Minister directs.
 - 6. Where a mixture of oils falls within item 15.07, being oil to which sub-item 15.07.1 does not apply, the mixture shall, for the purposes of a sub-item in item 15.07, be deemed to consist wholly of—
 - (a) if one only of the oils is an oil of a kind referred to in that sub-item—that oil;
 - (b) if two or more of the oils are oils of that kind and there is a greater quantity, by weight, of one of those oils than of any other—the oil of which there is a greater quantity; or
 - (c) in any other case—such one of those oils as the Minister directs.".

- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. S2156.

- 3. The Second Table of Customs By-law No. S2010, published in Gazette No. 60 dated 20 July 1970, as amended, is further amended, as follows:

Omit:

'Item 15.07 Rape seed oil, for use in the manufacture of factice, under security'.
