PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit PAUL HASLUCK Governor-General. By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Comwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section two of the Pig Slaughter Levy Act 1971 that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

NOW THEREFORE I, Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the first day of August, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, as the date on which the Pig Slaughter Levy Act 1971 shall come into operation.

GIVEN under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this twenty-ninth day of July, in the year of our (L.S.) Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's reign.

QUARANTINE PROCLAMATION No. 966

Commonwealth of Australia to wit PAUL HASLUCK Governor-General. By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Comwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 12 of the Quarantine Act 1908-1969 that the Governor-General may, by proclamation, declare that any place beyond or in Australia is infected with a quarantinable disease, or that a quarantinable disease may be brought or

carried from or through that place, and thereupon, and so long as the proclamation remains in force, that place shall be a proclaimed place within the meaning of that Act:

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of that Act, amongst other things, that, in that Act, unless the contrary intention appears, 'quarantinable disease' means, amongst other diseases, cholera:

NOW THEREFORE I, Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federation Executive Council, declare that cholera may be brought or carried from or through the territory of each of the countries specified in the Schedule to this Proclamation.
