Commonwealth of Australia ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

- I, SIR PAUL MEERNAA CAEDWALLA HASLUCK, the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby approve the following administrative arrangements:
 - (a) in addition to the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth at present administered by the Minister of State for Labour and National Service, the Child Care Act 1972 shall be administered by the Minister of State for Labour and National Service;
 - (b) in addition to the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth at present administered by the Prime Minister, the National Urban and Regional Development Authority Act 1972 shall be administered by the Prime Minister; and
 - (c) in addition to the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth at present administered by the Treasurer, the Companies (Foreign Take-overs) Act 1972 shall be administered by the Treasurer.
