WHEREAS by sub-section one of section seventy-six of the Public Service Act 1922-1972, it is provided that the Governor-General may proclaim any day to be observed as a holiday in the Commonwealth Service in lieu of any of the days mentioned in the sub-section;

AND WHEREAS it is desired that the holiday to celebrate the anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two should be observed in Commonwealth Offices in the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory of Australia on Monday, the twelfth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two in lieu of Friday, the twenty-first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two;

NOW THEREFORE I, Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby appoint Monday, the twelfth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, to be observed as a holiday in the Commonwealth Service in the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory of Australia in lieu of Friday, the twenty-first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two.
