Copies of each week's Special issues are also attached. General issues are published weekly at 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday and are sold at 25c each plus postage or on subscription of \$17.50 (full year), \$10.40 (six months), or \$5.20 (three months). Annual subscription includes quarterly index issues.

Special issues are made on urgent matters as required. Single copies are available on the day of issue at various prices according to size, and they are also provided at no extra charge with weekly General issues. Special issues are not available on separate subscription.

Periodic issues contain lengthy notices of a non-urgent nature, including the following: Certificates of Australian Citizenship; Registered Tax Agents; Authorised Celebrants; Australian Capital Territory Health Registers; Unclaimed moneys; Consolidated Customs by-laws, etc.; Consolidated notices of Australian Public Service appointment, recruitment and examination conditions; Appointments to the Australian Public Service. Issues are made at irregular intervals as required, at individual prices according to size. Advice of availability is given in the contents list of the General and Public Service issues immediately following the day of publication. Periodic issues are not available on subscription, but standing orders are accepted for all or selected issues.

Index issues contain an index of a limited number of entries in certain sections of Public Service issues, and all entries in the General issues except names in the Bankruptcy Act section. Index issues are published quarterly and are sold at 10c each plus postage. They are supplied without charge to annual subscribers to the General issues, but are not otherwise available on subscription.

SUBSCRIPTIONS are payable in advance and, unless otherwise requested, commence from the first issue of the month following the placement of an order. Rates include surface postage in Australia and overseas. Other carriage rates are available on application.

Fisheries Act 1952-1973

FISHERIES NOTICE No. 43

PROHIBITION RELATING TO THE TAKING OF PRAWNS FROM WATERS OFF THE NORTHERN COAST OF AUSTRALIA

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 8 of the Fisheries Act 1952-1973, I. Kenneth Shaw Wriedt, the Minister of State for Primary Industry, hereby prohibit the taking from the area of proclaimed waters specified in Schedule 1 of fish included in the class of fish specified in Schedule 2 during the period commencing at midnight on 31 January 1974 and ending at midnight on 14 March 1974.

SCHEDULE 1

All that area of proclaimed waters contained within the area bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the parallel 12 degrees 14 minutes south latitude with the western shore of Cape York Peninsula at low-water mark; thence proceeding westward along that parallel to its intersection with an imaginary line drawn at a distance of 12 nautical miles to seaward from the low-water mark; thence following that imaginary line to the point of its intersection with the parallel 12 degrees 34.4 minutes south latitude; thence following a straight line drawn from that point to the point 12 degrees 55.9 minutes south latitude 141 degrees 23.5 minutes east longitude; thence proceeding southward and westward along an imaginary line drawn at a distance of 12 nautical miles to seaward from the low-water mark to its intersection with the meridian 137 degrees 45.25 minutes east longitude; thence proceeding southward along that meridian to its intersection with the northern shore of Australia at low-water mark; thence following the northern shore of Australia at low-water mark to the point of commencement.

PHARMACEUTICAL BENEFITS

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 93 OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH ACT

I, DOUGLAS NIXON EVERINGHAM, Minister of State for Health pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 93 of the National Health Act 1953-1973, HERBY REVOKE all previous Determinations made pursuant to Section 93 of the National Health Act and HERBY DETERMINE that:

- (1) This Determination shall come into operation on the first day of December 1973.
- (2) The Pharmaceutical benefits referred to in this Determination shall be those contained in the Schedule attached to this Determination.
- (3) A medical practitioner is authorised for the purposes of Section 93 of the Act, to supply any of the pharmaceutical benefits obtained by him in pursuance to this Determination.
- (4) Subject to this Determination, the maximum quantity or number of units of a pharmaceutical benefit that may be obtained by a medical practitioner in any one month for the purpose of Section 93 of the Act is the number or quantity specified in the Schedule to this Determination in relation to the pharmaceutical benefit.

- (5) Where a medical practitioner has obtained a pharmaceutical benefit for the purpose of Section 93 of the Act, he is not entitled to obtain a further quantity or number of units of that pharmaceutical benefit for that purpose while he has in his possession a quantity or number of units of the pharmaceutical benefit obtained for that purpose equal to or greater than the maximum quantity or number of units allowed for the pharmaceutical benefit by the last preceding clause.
- (6) A medical practitioner is not entitled to obtain a pharmaceutical benefit for the purpose of Section 93 of the Act more often than twice in any two months.


