# PR-134: Field evaluation of a transgenic line of field pea (*Pisum sativum* L.) for resistance to Ascochyta blight

PR-135: Field evaluation of transgenic lines of field pea (*Pisum sativum* L.) with enhanced grain protein levels

**Purpose of the release:** Two pea cultivars have been modified for improved nutritional quality by introducing a protein that is unusually rich in sulfur-containing amino acids. The peas have been shown to have significantly higher total levels of seed protein. The aim of this trial is to determine if the high protein levels are found in field-grown peas.

Brief description of the nature and effect of the genetic modification: A gene coding for a sulfur-rich seed protein found in sunflower (*Helianthus annuus*) has been introduced into two commercial pea cultivars to improve nutritional quality. In addition, the peas also express a gene from the bacterium *Streptomyces hygroscopicus* that confers resistance to the herbicide glufosinate ammonium (Basta<sup>®</sup>) and a gene from the bacterium *Escherichia coli* encoding the screenable marker β-glucuronidase (GUS).

**Location and size of trial:** Up to 100 transgenic plants are to be grown on the CSIRO Black Mountain campus, Canberra, ACT.

## PR-136: Field maintenance and propagation of sugarcane modified for sucrose metabolism and juice colour

Purpose of the release: The plants will be grown to obtain mature cane for harvest and propagation increase. This will provide bulk stalk samples for juice extraction for laboratory evaluation of sucrose, juice colour and crystal colour. These evaluations, if successful, will lead to yield and agronomic assessment of selected transgenic lines.

Brief description of the nature and effect of the genetic modification: Two different lines of genetically modified sugarcane will be grown. One variety has been modified by the introduction of copies of sections of the sugarcane invertase gene. Invertase is a key enzyme in sugar production. The modification is designed to block the activity of the invertase gene and increase the sugar content of the plants.

In the second line, copies of sections of the sugarcane polyphenol oxidase (PPO) gene have been introduced. PPO is an enzyme responsible for the browning of juice and crystals from sugarcane. The aim of the modification is to block the action of the PPO gene so that the sugar has lower colour and higher quality. These plants also contain a gene for a green fluorescent protein from jellyfish. This acts as a marker to distinguish genetically modified from unmodified plants.

In addition, both lines of sugarcane express the marker gene aphA, which confers resistance to the antibiotic geneticin, and is used to select genetically modified plants in the laboratory.

Location and size of trial: Up to 0.1 hectares at a CSIRO site at Townsville, 0.3 hectares at Brisbane, and either 0.26 hectares at Ayr or 0.4 hectares near Halifax, Queensland.

Labelling of Foods Containing Alcohol (P219) A proposal to require foods containing
more than 1.15% alcohol to declare the alcohol concentration and, for foods containing

- I, WILLIAM PATRICK DEANE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal ("AASM") Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 13 September 1988, ("the Regulations"), and on the recommendation of the Minister for Defence, hereby:
- declare, under regulation 3 of the Regulations, the following warlike (a) operations in which members of the Australian Defence Force are engaged in the area comprising East Timor and the sea adjacent to East Timor out to a distance of 12 nautical miles from the low water mark to be a prescribed operation for the purposes of the Regulations:
  - Operation 'Faber' that commenced on 16 September 1999; (i)
  - (ii) Operation 'Warden' that commenced on 16 September 1999;
  - (iii) Operation 'Tanager' that commenced on 20 February 2000;
- (b) determine, under subregulation 4(2) of the Regulations, that the conditions for the award of the AASM with Clasp 'EAST TIMOR' ("the Medal") for that prescribed operation are:
  - (i) the Medal may be awarded to a member of the Australian Defence Force who rendered service as such a member while posted as a member of the Australian element of the prescribed operation for a prescribed period;
  - (ii) the Medal may be awarded to a member of the Australian Defence Force who rendered service as such a member for a prescribed period as part of the contribution of a foreign

Defence Force to the prescribed operation while on secondment or exchange with that foreign Defence Force;

- (iii) the Medal may be awarded to a member of the Australian Defence Force who rendered service as such a member and who completed a prescribed number of sorties within the duration of the prescribed operation;
- the Medal may be awarded to a member of the Australian (iv) Defence Force who rendered service as such a member and who for a prescribed period, undertook official visits, inspections or other occurrences of a temporary nature in connection with the military contribution in the prescribed operation;
- the Medal may be awarded to a person who rendered service as (v) part of the Australian element of the prescribed operation for a prescribed period and who, in accordance with a determination made by the Minister under paragraph 4(4)(b) of the Regulations, is in a class of persons who may be awarded the Medal:
- in this paragraph "prescribed period" means: (vi)
  - (A) in relation to subparagraphs (b)(i), (ii) and (v), a period of not less than one day;
  - (B) in relation to subparagraph (b)(iv), a period of not less than an aggregate of 30 days,

PROVIDED THAT where a member does not complete the prescribed period required by subparagraphs (b)(i), (ii), (iv) or (v) owing to his or her death, evacuation due to illness, injury or other disability due to service, the member will be deemed to have completed that prescribed period.

- in this paragraph "prescribed number of sorties" means: (vii)
  - (A) one operational sortie from a unit assigned to the prescribed operation; or
  - (B) 30 non-operational sorties from any unit, not necessarily assigned to the prescribed operation, where those sorties were conducted over a period of not less than an aggregate of 30 days at a rate of one sortie per day,

PROVIDED THAT where a member does not complete the required *prescribed number of sorties* owing to his or her death, evacuation due to illness, injury or other disability due to service, the member will be deemed to have completed the *prescribed number of sorties*.
