Under sub-section 102A(1) of the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996* (WA), if:

- (a) the Director or the Minister has reasonable grounds to believe that a publication is a submittable publication; and
- (b) the publication is being published in Western Australia, or the Director or the Minister has reasonable grounds to believe that it will be published in Western Australia,

the Director or the Minister may, by notice in writing given to the publisher of the publication, require the publisher to submit an application for classification of the publication, or of subsequent issues of the publication, by the Board.

I also have the power to call-in submittable publications published in Victoria, under section 60 of the Victorian *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) (Enforcement) Act 1995*.

'Publication' is defined in section 5 of the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Act 1995* (Cth) (the Commonwealth Act) to mean:

Any written or pictorial matter, but does not include:

- a) a film; or
- b) a computer game; or
- c) an advertisement for a publication, a film or a computer game.

'Submittable publication' is defined in section 5 of the Commonwealth Act to mean:

an unclassified publication that, having regard to section 9A or to the Code and the classification guidelines to the extent that they relate to publications, contains depictions or descriptions that:

- (a) are likely to cause the publication to be classified RC; or
- (b) are likely to cause offence to a reasonable adult to the extent that the publication should not be sold or displayed as an unrestricted publication; or
- (c) are unsuitable for a minor to see or read.

'Publish' is defined in section 5 of the Commonwealth Act to include 'sell, offer for sale, let on hire, exhibit, display, distribute and demonstrate'.

It is an offence in WA to sell or supply a submittable publication: subsection 61(1) of the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996* (WA).

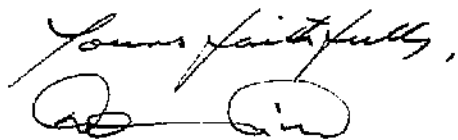
I have reasonable grounds to believe the above named board game is a submittable publication and I believe it has been published in Western Australia.

The table at the attached Schedule depicts the registration outcome for any person already licensed in an occupation in a particular jurisdiction (column A of each row) should they seek to be licensed in an occupation in a second jurisdiction (potentially in any other column in the same row). Registration shall be granted by the second jurisdiction in the terms specified provided the applicant is already registered in the equivalent occupation in the first jurisdiction.

If an applicant for mutual recognition holds a licence shown in Column A of a Schedule, but has additional condition/s applying to that licence not shown in the Schedule, then the relevant registration authority in the second jurisdiction shall recognise the primary licence in Column A and may, in issuing a licence, apply those additional conditions to directly replicate the conditions applying to the first jurisdiction licence.

If a licence is not included in the declaration, or if the licence outcome depicted on the Schedule is the statement 'No equivalent declared', the decision on licence recognition will be made by the relevant registration authority in accordance with the other provisions of the *Mutual Recognition Act 1992*.

Licences covered by this declaration are licences that are issued to natural persons, not licences issued to companies.

This declaration and any subsequent declarations will be reviewed for accuracy each year. Declarations and any revised declarations will be published on the COAG mutual recognition website and the websites of the relevant licensing authorities.

Limited and Controlled Release of Genetically Modified (GM) Wheat

Australia's gene technology regulatory system is designed to protect the health and safety of people and the environment by identifying risks posed by, or as a result of, gene technology and managing those risks.

The Acting Gene Technology Regulator is currently assessing Licence Application DIR 092 from CSIRO for a limited and controlled release to undertake research with 16 wheat lines genetically modified for altered grain composition.

The purpose of the trial is to evaluate grain properties of the GM wheat lines grown under field conditions. Some seed would be collected and retained for analysis and possible future trials, subject to further approval(s). The trial is proposed to take place, under limited and controlled conditions, at one site in the ACT, on a maximum area of 1 ha from 2009-2012. Plant materials from the GM wheat will not enter the commercial animal feed or human food supply chain. However, some products made from the GM wheat may be fed to rats and pigs in controlled laboratory experiments.

A consultation Risk Assessment and Risk Management Plan (RARMP) has been prepared, which concludes that the proposed release would pose negligible risk to human health and safety or to the environment. A range of licence conditions are proposed, including measures to restrict the release to the size, location and duration requested by CSIRO.

The Acting Regulator welcomes written submissions in order to finalise the RARMP, which will then form the basis of a decision on whether to issue the licence. Note 1 This notice corrects and replaces a notice signed on 24 June 2002 which was effective on and from 1 July 2002. That notice wrongly recorded the ACN of the Applicant. It is for this reason that this authorisation takes effect on and from 1 July 2002 and not the date it is signed.

Note 2 Under subsection 12(4) of the Act, if APRA authorises an applicant, APRA must give written notice to the applicant and ensure that notice of the authorisation is published in the *Gazette*.

Note 3 APRA may revoke an authorisation in accordance with sections 15 and 16 of the Act.

Note 4 Under subsection 13(1) of the Act, APRA may, at any time, by written notice to a general insurer, impose conditions or additional conditions or vary or revoke conditions imposed on the insurer's authorisation under section 12 of the Act. The conditions must relate to prudential matters.

Note 5 Under subsection 14(1) of the Act, a general insurer commits an offence if:

- (a) the insurer does an act or fails to do an act; and
- (b) doing the act or failing to do the act results in a contravention of a condition of the insurer's authorisation under section 12 of the Act; and
- (c) there is no determination in force under subsection 7(1) of the Act, that subsection 14(1) of the Act does not apply to the insurer.

The maximum penalty is 300 penalty units. 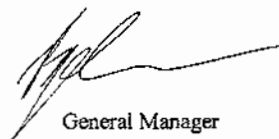
